2018 Student Care Service Information for Primary 1 Parents**1. About Pro-Teach**

Pro-Teach Education Group has been appointed to operate the Student Care Centre (SCC) in Ai Tong School since 2014. We aim to provide your child with a diverse education in an environment that promotes self-discipline, character development and excellence in learning.

Pro-Teach began our operations in 1998, providing quality student care and education for children between the ages of 7 to 12 years old. We have 40 branches nationwide with centres in Hong Wen, Horizon, Compassvale, Wellington, Fernvale, Palm View, Dazhong, Westwood, Townsville and Ai Tong School.

2. Admission Criteria

School-based SCC primarily caters to children from needy families. It provides care support to children without adequate home support outside school hours. The following is the admission criteria for the SCC in Ai Tong School:

- a) Singapore Citizen
- b) Priority given to students under the Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS)
- c) Both parents or single parent must be employed
- d) Siblings

3. Pro-Teach Services and Programmes

In addition to close supervision of school homework and spelling training, we are offering an exciting array of programmes specially designed for your child's holistic development. Breakfast/lunch/tea-break will be provided.

Pro-Teach Dynamic Kid Programme

Goodness Me!

Movies are used as a medium to deliver lessons on character values. Students learn from analysing selected scenes where the character displays exceptional values followed by activities that further emphasise the lesson objectives.

Pro-Teach Media World™

Students become voiceover artists, learn to speak like a news anchor, write scripts like a scriptwriter and communicate like an advertiser. The lessons are filled with media-rich activities which offer plenty of opportunities to develop public speaking confidence, hone their writing skills and above all enjoy the English language!

Math Booster

Math concepts are broken down into simpler parts and ordered in progressive steps for students to develop their understanding at a manageable pace. In a small class environment, the teachers are able to interact more actively with the students to help them understand mathematical concepts and master a variety of solving strategies.

Integrated Media Learning (i-Learning)

Science concepts are explained via animations while English development is achieved through games in the i-Learning programme. It covers topics within the MOE syllabus and uses animation and audio to create fun and engaging learning experiences that teach fundamental concepts.

5. Student Care Financial Scheme (SCFA)

Student care subsidies under the MSF Student Care Financial Assistance Scheme are given to families whose gross monthly household income is \$4,000 and below. For families with 5 or more members residing in the same household, the gross per capita income* should not exceed \$1000.

$$\text{*gross per capita income} = \frac{\text{Monthly gross household income (father + mother)}}{\text{Total no. of family members within the same household}}$$

Other criteria:

- 1) Both parents must be employed.
- 2) Child is Singapore citizen. If the child is a PR, at least 1 member of immediate family is Singapore citizen.

7. Evening Dismissal Procedure

Pro-Teach operations must be aligned closely with the school's procedures. School gates operation time must be adhered to. Parents can walk in or drive in to pick up their child at the Foyer from 6:00pm to 7:00pm.
