LET'S JAM TOGETHER!

A. OVERVIEW



- *Let's Jam Together!* is one of the platforms featured in this year's SYFgoesOnline! Through *Let's Jam Together!*, we aim to provide an opportunity for aspiring singers to perform virtually with the Singapore acapella group **MICappella** to the song "Glow". This song is written by student songwriter, Jayne Peh for the SYF Youth Station Project – Original Songs 2020.
- "Glow" is an empowering song about how we overcome obstacles in difficult times and support each other in our endeavour to learn and grow. We hope that its message of the determination to shine and become a better person will inspire you!

B. PARTICIPATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- *Let's Jam Together!* is open to students in all MOE Primary and Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges, Millennia Institute and Special Education Schools. Each student can participate in more than one entry. Students from different schools can submit a joint entry if they wish (see para below for important guidelines).
- **All practices and recordings must be done individually and at home and stitched together using software/apps. For group participation, unless living in the same household, you are not allowed to congregate in one venue to practise or record your song with your group members. This is in adherence to the latest Safe Management Measures (SMM). Videos that show non-compliance to the above will be rejected.**
- You may participate individually or in a group of no more than 5. Video clips will be shortlisted and featured on the SYF social media pages based on:
 - **Creativity:** Your performance is interesting and innovative in terms of visual presentation and performance.
 - **Technique:** Your performance demonstrates musical skills (i.e. pitch, rhythm, coordination, etc.).
 - **Aesthetic appeal:** Your performance is pleasing and captivating to watch.

C. HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN LET'S JAM TOGETHER!

Step 1:	Seek parental/guardian consent for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participation in <i>Let's Jam Together!</i> • Featuring you and/ or your submission on SYF social media platforms (Facebook, Instagram, YouTube).

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Step 3:	Watch the Demonstration Video (“Demo Video.mp4”) and refer to the score and lyrics (“Music_Score.pdf” and “Lyrics.pdf”) to be familiar with the song.								
Step 4:	Decide on the vocal part(s) (Voice 1, Voice 2 or both) that you and/or your group will sing.								
Step 5:	Choose: 1) Video Template 1 (“Video Template 1.mp4”) for singing only Voice 1 . OR 2) Video Template 2 (“Video Template 2.mp4”) for singing Voices 1 and 2 . Check the blank space in the chosen Video Template to ensure that it can fit your recorded video(s) without covering or overlapping with the areas featuring the MICappella singers . You may do so by deciding on the dimension and orientation (portrait or landscape) of your video(s) before recording. In editing the video(s) later, you may also need to resize or crop your video(s) to fit.								

Step 6:	Watch the Video Recording Instruction (“Video Recording Guide. mp4”) carefully. It will help you to complete this activity smoothly!
Step 7:	Practise and video-record your vocal part(s) by referring to Guiding Track Voice 1 or 2 (“Guiding Track_Voice 1.mp4” or “Guiding Track_Voice 2.mp4”).
Step 8:	<p>For video stitching and editing, insert and synchronise your video recording(s) into the blank space provided in the selected Video Template. You may use the following free video-editing apps or any other means to insert your video:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kinemaster (iOS, Android) • iMovie (iOS, MacOS) • OpenShot Video Editor (Windows, MacOS, Chrome OS) <p>The Video Editing Guide (“Video Editing Guide.pdf”), based on Kinemaster, will help you understand the editing process, although you may be using a different video editing software.</p> <p>Remember to use the audio Click Track (“Click Track.mp3”) to help you synchronise your video(s). However, the <u>Click Track should not be included in the finalised video for submission.</u></p>
Step 9:	<p>Export your video with quality 1080p at 30 frames per second in the following filename format:</p> <p><PlatformNameWithoutSpaces>_<SchoolNameWithoutSpaces>_<StudentNameWithoutSpaces> (e.g. LetsJamTogether_SunshinePrimary_MayLee).</p>
Step 10:	<p>Upload the completed video on Dropbox or Google Drive, ensuring that <u>anyone with the link can view</u> the video.</p> <div data-bbox="423 1367 1425 1577" style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 10px; background-color: #f9f9f9;">  </div>
Step 11:	<p>Submit your entry online by scanning the QR Code or clicking the link:</p> <div data-bbox="782 1667 1068 1929" style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p style="text-align: center;">https://go.gov.sg/syf2021letsjamtogether</p>

All submissions must reach us by **2 July 2021**. Late entries will not be accepted.

Note:

- We will reject videos with poor screen resolution or audio quality, or which fail to download.
- All registrants will be notified via e-mail of the outcome within a week from this date.

You are required to fill in these details in the online form:

- Parents'/ Guardians' name and contact (only for Primary school students)

D. WHAT TO WEAR

1. Choice of style and appearance should be modest and appropriate for audience on Ministry of Education (MOE) and Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) social media platforms.
2. Refer to the table below for a list of Dos and Don'ts:

	Dos	Don'ts
Attire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Wear modest and age-appropriate attire that allows you to move with ease and safely. ✓ Wear attire of a different colour from the background. ✓ All colours (preferably bright ones) are welcome, <u>but</u> predominantly black outfits are discouraged. ✓ Wear attire that reflects your performance genre (where possible). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Don't wear revealing attire (for example, clothing made of translucent materials, spaghetti-strap tops, tube tops, crop tops, hot pants etc.). ✗ Don't wear attire that suggests drugs, tobacco, alcohol, violence, sexual content, religions or politics. ✗ Avoid shiny items (e.g. shiny buttons)

	✓ Follow your school rules if you choose to wear school-related attire.	
Hair	✓ Ensure neat hairstyles appropriate to the genre presented	✗ Don't have hairstyles that cover facial features or block your vision.

Video clips that are deemed unsuitable will not be featured on the MOE and SYF platforms at all.

E. COPYRIGHT GUIDELINES TO TAKE NOTE OF

- When submitting any photographs/audio recordings/video recordings to the Ministry of Education and Singapore Youth Festival, you should:
 - Be the creator/owner of all the material submitted (except where the platform has provided material for you to work with).
 - Have sought permission from the owner(s) when using material from another source or person.
 - Have sought permission from any person(s) included in your submitted material.
- In submitting your photographs/audio recordings/video recordings to the Ministry of Education (MOE) and Singapore Youth Festival, you have **granted MOE a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide license to use and reproduce the photographs, audio and video recordings**. MOE shall be entitled to use the materials contained in the entries, in full or partially, to advertise, publicise, in various media of its choosing, including, but not limited to, newspapers, magazines, publications, radio, television, public screenings and any other electronic media including, but not limited to, the Internet, or for other purposes in a manner it deems fit to showcase our education system.
