ART LABS 2021

A. OVERVIEW

- *Art Labs* is one of the platforms featured in *SYFgoesOnline!* Through *Art Labs*, we aim to develop your artistic voice by providing opportunities for you to think about and explore ways to creatively express your own ideas.
- *Art Labs 2021* is open to all students in MOE Primary and Secondary schools, Junior Colleges and Millennia Institute, as well as Special Education Schools.
- The *Art Labs 2021* Art Toolkit contains **four** specially designed activities for you. You may choose to do one or all the activities. For each activity, you may submit only 1 entry. Selected artworks will be exhibited on our SYF website and/or social media.
- All activities must be done within prevailing safe management measures (SMM) (e.g. **only at home** during current Phase 2 (heightened alert) period).

B. HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN ART LABS 2021

Step 1:

Seek parental/guardian consent for:

- Participating in *Art Labs 2021*
- Featuring you and/or your submission on social media

Step 2:

Decide on the activity/activities in the Art Toolkit to participate in.

- You may choose to do one or all the activities in the Art Toolkit. For each activity, you may submit only one entry.

Step 3:

Complete the activity/activities that you have chosen.

Step 4:

Submit your entry/entries online

Click on the link or scan the QR code. All submissions must reach us by 21 June 2021, 12pm.

You are required to fill in these details on the online form:

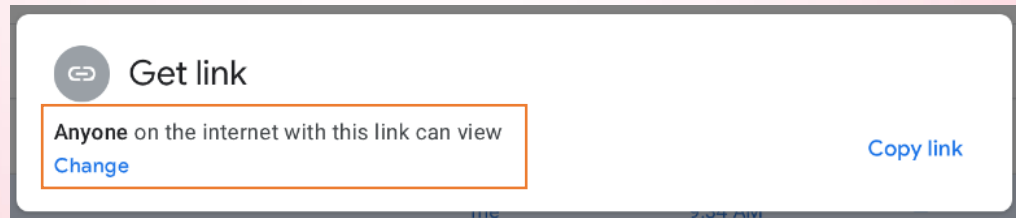
- Your full name (this will be used on the certificate which you will receive in September 2021 for your participation in *Art Labs 2021*);
- School;
- Class;
- Contact number;
- Email address;
- Parents'/Guardians' name and contact (for primary school participants);
- Link to the Dropbox or Google Drive folder with your artwork in the required format (i.e. photo (activity 1 -3), GIF (activity 4); and
- Artist statement (no more than 50 words).

¹ Only for participants aged 13 and above

Uploading your photo/GIF

Upload your photo/GIF in a folder on [Dropbox](#) or [Google Drive](#) and share the link of your folder when you register.

When sharing on [Google drive](#), make sure that the link sharing setting is set to “Anyone with the link can view”.



Name your photo/GIF the following format:

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D. THINGS TO NOTE WHEN SUBMITTING FOR ART LABS 2021

Photo/GIF should follow these specifications:

- ✓ Activity 1 – 3: JPEG (.jpg) file format
- ✓ Activity 4: GIF (.gif) file format
- ✗ Must not include water marks, borders or signatures
- ✗ Must not exceed 7MB

Your submission(s) must not

- ✗ Contain any depictions or activities that are deemed indecent, offensive, politically insensitive, racially insensitive, or unlawful.
- ✗ Include watermarks, borders or signatures.
- ✗ Be concurrently and/or previously submitted for other competitions, distributed or accepted for broadcast through any mass media.

Photo/GIF with poor on-screen resolution or that fail to download will be rejected. Entries that are incomplete, incorrectly filled in and/or submitted late will not be accepted.

E. SELECTION

Artworks will be selected for feature based on:

- **Clarity of artistic intention**
Your artwork and artist statement are clear and coherent
- **Effective use of materials and tools to express intention(s) of artwork**
Shows good understanding and effective use of materials and tools in your art making

F. HOW TO STAY SAFE WHEN PARTICIPATING IN ART LABS 2021

1. *Art Labs* is part of *SYFgoesOnline!* which is an online festival.
2. To stay safe, ensure that:
 - you adhere to socially acceptable netiquette when interacting with online materials and comments on MOE/SYF social media platforms;
 - you do not participate in cyberbullying behaviours including, but not limited to, flaming, harassment, cyber stalking and denigration.

G. COPYRIGHT GUIDELINES TO TAKE NOTE OF

1. When submitting any artworks/photos/audio recordings/video recordings to the Ministry of Education and Singapore Youth Festival, you should:
 - be the creator/owner of all the material submitted (except where the platform has provided material for you to work with); music that is used must be copyright-free (note that pop songs are usually copyrighted hence should not be used unless copyright consent is obtained – see the point below);
 - have sought permission from the owner(s) for the use of symbols such as brands and logos, and/or using material from another source or person in the photo/video; and
 - have sought consent from any person(s) included/featured in your submitted material.
2. Copyright to the materials submitted for *SYFgoesOnline!* reside with the student. By participating in the *SYFgoesOnline! Art Labs 2021*, you grant the Ministry of Education the perpetual and irrevocable right, non-exclusive, worldwide license, to use and distribute the materials contained in the entries, in full or partially, in various media of its choosing, including, but not limited to, newspapers, magazines, publications, radio, television, public screenings and any other electronic media including, but not limited to, the Internet, or for other purposes in a manner it deems fit in its communication to the public.
